Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations (PUWER) Awareness

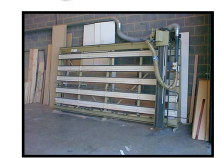


PUWER is designed for anyone with responsibility directly or indirectly for the supply of work equipment and its use, such as employers, managers, employees, the self-employed and those who hire work equipment. This course is specifically designed for the application of PUWER to provide suitable equipment for the task/work in the required condition, and be able to undertake inspections, demonstrations/familiarisations, correct recording and compliance etc. The course will be delivered in relation to the requirements of the individual company utilising that company's equipment type and range.

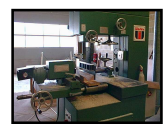


Duration
